CLINICAL PLACEMENT PROGRAM

IN CANCER SURVIVORSHIP 2022-2024

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Funded by the Victorian Government, this program aims to improve access to quality cancer survivorship care. This will be achieved by offering allied health professionals (AHPs) and practice nurses (PNs) placements in cancer survivorship to enhance their capacity to deliver appropriate services and information.

The Australian Cancer Survivorship Centre (ACSC) has previously run three successful iterations of this program.



HOST SITES

We are seeking a minimum of 8 host sites, hosting at least 10-20 placements per site

To participate, host sites can be:

- acute /rehabilitation hospitals
- community rehabilitation centres
- · community health services

who provide **oncology specific care**; ideally, with a focus on follow-up / survivorship care.

Host site application: May 2022 - Aug 2022 Placements will run: Sept 2022 - Apr 2024



PARTICIPANTS

Target: 150 participants*

This iteration will focus on reaching at least 40% rural/regional participants comprising of AHPs (75%) and PNs (25%)

*Participant recruitment will be coordinated by the ACSC
