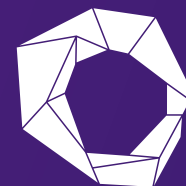


# DISRUPTION TO FLEMINGTON ROAD AND GRATTAN STREET

## Information for Patients, Carers and Families

**City West Water is undertaking significant upgrade works to water main pipes along Flemington Road and Grattan Street in front of Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.**

### TIMING AND WORKS

The works will start on 27 July 2016 and are expected to be completed by 21 September 2016.

The majority of the works will take place between 7:30pm–6:00am, from Sunday through to Thursday, however there will also be some work that will be conducted during the day.

City West Water has advised us that the works will involve excavation of the inner left hand slow lane road surface along Flemington Road, Grattan Street and Wreckyn Street (see map bottom right). There will also be some expected noise from these works and impacts on traffic conditions including lane closures and redirections around our home.

### ACCESS TO OUR CAR PARK

During business hours Flemington Road will be reinstated via the use of metal road plates ensuring Peter Mac's Ambulance Bay and visitor car park entrance will always be accessible.

However, should out of hours access to the car park be required – traffic controllers will assist you with gaining access. We ask that if you need assistance from a traffic controller during the night, please seek their attention by pulling over and turning on your vehicle hazard lights. This will draw you to their attention and they will happily attend to you and direct you accordingly.

We advise that during this period, in planning for your visit to Peter Mac, you leave plenty of time to arrive for your appointments in case of traffic delays in the precinct.

### PUBLIC TRANSPORT IMPACTS

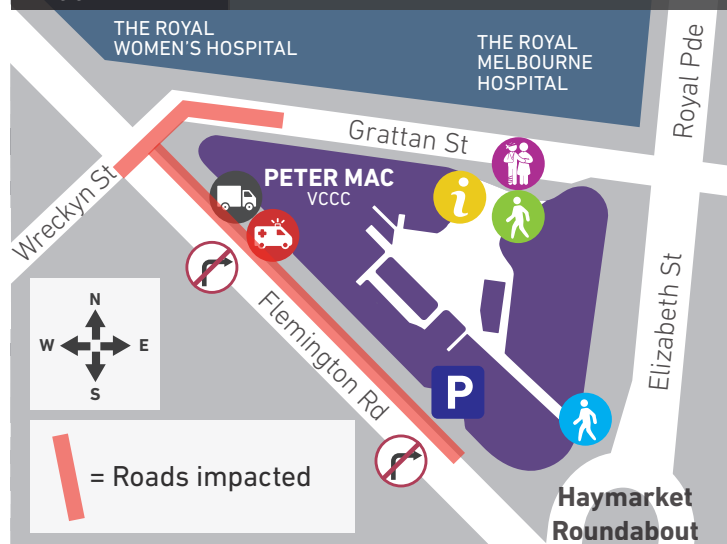
There is no impact on public transport to the area, other than the possibility of the 401/402/403 bus stop on the VCCC building side of Grattan Street being relocated for a period of time during the construction program. We will endeavour to keep our patients, their carers and families informed of these likely impacts via our website and social media channels.

### NOISE IMPACTS

At times, some construction noise will occur during the night. We don't expect this will have a major impact on our inpatients, however if you do have any concerns we ask that you speak to your Nurse Unit Manager.
