



Video-consultation for regional patients when clinically appropriate

including for follow-up / second opinion / review / new

Telehealth can be run from Specialist Clinics,
clinical offices or anywhere with a computer, webcam and internet

The patient or their local clinician will need:

- A computer or tablet (eg iPad, Smartphone etc) with camera, speakers, internet and Chrome and the website address: www.petermac.org/telehealth

All this information is on the appointment letter
given to the patient when the appointment is booked.

As a provider (e.g. Peter Mac clinician) you will need:

- A telehealth logon (request via ICT x98222)
- To have completed basic telehealth upskilling
- A telehealth super-user in your admin support team

You can request telehealth during discharge planning
or when requesting an appointment follow-up. Specify:

- Telehealth – patient only, OR
- Telehealth – with local clinician (*ideally include clinician details*)
